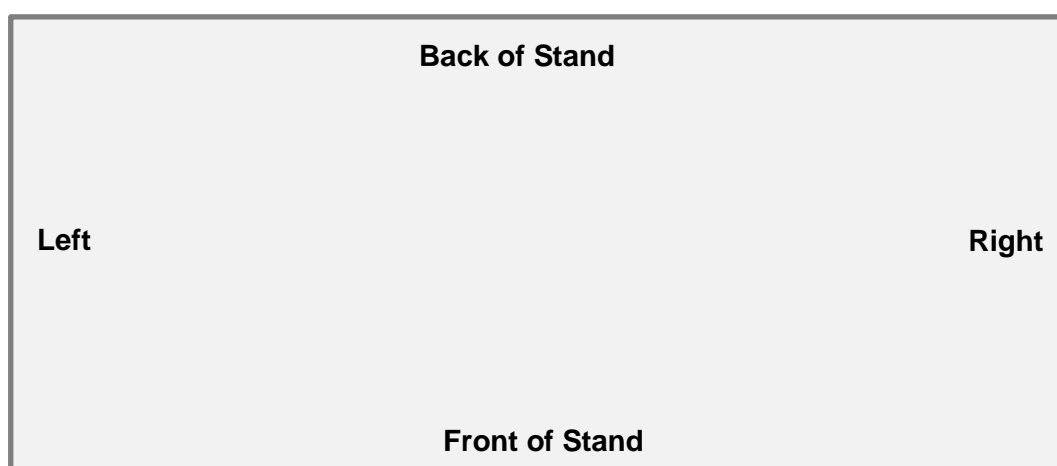

- Once you confirm an install and dismantle time you will need to stick to this time. Delayed installations will incur staff labour charges for each hour of delay
- All plumbing and equipment is supplied and fitted by a qualified plumber (contracted by the GCCEC) or a qualified member of the GCCEC maintenance staff
- A number of floor pits in the GCCEC are supplied with non-potable water
- The waste service only allows for the disposal of clean water waste, as these lines go straight to sewage. The floor pits are not designed for effluents or untreated trade waste discharges (ie. solvents, paints, fat and grease)
